Apologies were received from Cllrs. Johnston and Turner.

Following an in depth conversation it was agreed unanimously that:

- 1. The number of items would be reduced to 10 units plus the rest shelter in a single line along the path edge, including some that are suitable for children to use.
- 2. The 3 year maintenance contract would be accepted on condition that it could be rolled over after 3 years up to a total of 10 years.
- 3. One area of matting should be installed under all items.
- 4. The new plans would be presented to the village at the 20th anniversary celebrations being held at the village hall on 22nd April.
- 5. The school would be approached about the possibility of them using the equipment for their P.E. lessons.

Following the receipt of amended quotations and the results from the village consultation the Councillors will make a final decision at the May Council meeting then an order will be placed.




Figure 1 - proposed layout of equipment

Figure 1 shows the proposed layout of the outdoor gym equipment.
